



Acceptance of the general terms and conditions for requesting international freight train paths through the Rail Freight Corridor 6 (RFC6) one stop shop

Considering that the RFC6 corridor-one stop shop (“C-OSS”) is **EEIG European Economic Interest Group** incorporated under the Law of Italy and registered seat in via Ernesto Breda n.28, 20126 Milan, Italy, listed in the “Register of Companies” held by Camera di Commercio Industria - Artigianato e Agricoltura of Milan, under no. 09600641006 and in the R.E.A. of Milano under no. MI-2031163, fiscal code 09600641006.

The applicant has read, understood and accepted the RFC 6 Corridor Information Document and, in particular, its Book IV which states the procedures for requesting and allocating international freight paths through the RFC 6 one stop shop.

The EEIG RFC6, as C-OSS, shall only be held liable for direct damages caused to the applicant due to the breach of one of the obligations of the C-OSS as described in chapter 3 of part IV of the Corridor Information Document.

The EEIG RFC6 shall not be held liable for any damage caused to the applicant due to the breach by one or several IMs/ABs involved in the requested paths of one of the obligations described the Corridor Information Document
